Why are we having another capital campaign?

About 12 years ago, this church decided that building a new sanctuary would help us fulfill our mission by better accommodating a larger congregation with our diverse worship needs. At the time, it was a very ambitious project, costing over \$3 million. Through your generosity, we have been able to pay down much of the loan, but we still project that by the end of the 4th capital campaign, we will owe about \$1,500,000 on our loan. While we are currently able to meet the payments on this loan, we believe that this debt is hindering us from fully living out God's mission for us.

What can we accomplish if our debt is eliminated?

Our church has always been a leader in helping those less fortunate in our community by making Jesus known. During the Listening Posts held last summer, members of the church consistently stated that they wanted to reach out more than ever before. Imagine what we could do to further God's mission if every sacrificed for the next three years and helped us become debt free. This would free up more monies and energy for spreading the gospel message through mission, worship, and incredible ministries!

What do we need to raise to eliminate our debt?

At our current rate of payment, it would take us 10 ½ years to pay off our loan. However, we have calculated that if we were to raise \$1,650,000 over the next three years, we could be entirely out of debt. This is certainly ambitious, but it can be reachable if every family in the church is willing to make a sacrifice.

What will be asked of me and my family?

Right now: **PRAY!** As we move into our 5th Capital Campaign, prepare your heart to respond to God's call to action. Ask the Lord what He would have you do to fulfill his mission for our church as we Imagine Our Future. **LISTEN!** Be open to what God will teach you through this experience. Trust that He will provide whatever He impresses on you to contribute. Expect the unbelievable, for we serve a God who always provides more than we can ask or imagine. **GIVE!** Respond in faith with a three-year commitment pledge. We don't expect every person to give an equal share, but we do trust that each of you will make the same level of sacrifice. As we do, prepare for the Lord to work through us for years to come, guiding us as we come to Know Jesus and Make Him Known.

Dear Lea Joyner Family,


